Learning Day #2: Hiring & Personal Awareness

Keynote from social psychologist **Amy Cuddy** 
Skill Builder from author **Geoff Smart** 

What comes to mind when you hear *people skills*? Most of us need a better, more impactful understanding of people—especially those that make our businesses tick. This Learning Day is focused on hiring and recruitment methodology, as well as the psychological impact of body language on success.



Amy Cuddy is a social psychologist and professor at Harvard Business School. She studies how our body language speaks not only to others, but also to ourselves. Specifically, her research focuses on how adopting powerful, expansive postures (imagine Wonder Woman) helps us to be more present in high-pressure situations, changing our thoughts, feelings, behaviors, and

physiology, as well as impacting how well—or poorly—we perform in job interviews, difficult conversations, public speeches, and more.

Geoff Smart is considered the number one thought leader on the number one topic in business: hiring talented teams and then running them at full power. Geoff is the highest-rated speaker on this topic globally.
